### CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

1. For the fees quoted The Writers Bureau College of Journalism will provide the course and services described in the Prospectus.
2. If you are paying your fees by instalments, you agree to pay these promptly to our Manchester Office as they fall due, irrespective of the speed at which you study. If an instalment becomes more than two months overdue, you automatically forfeit your right to any refund under the Guarantees below, unless an extended payment period has been agreed between us in advance. If there is any danger of your instalment payments being delayed, please write to us. We will treat all deserving cases as sympathetically as possible and do our best to adjust your payments to your circumstances.
3. This agreement lasts for four years. If you wish to extend your studies beyond four years, an extra charge may be made for administration and the supply of revised course material.
4. The course material becomes your property on receipt of full payment.
5. The Writers Bureau College of Journalism reserves the right to refuse to accept any applications for enrolment.
6. You agree to follow your tutor's advice; to study the course conscientiously in order to give it a fair chance to help you; to take all reasonable steps to have your writing published and to keep us informed of the results of all submissions you make during and up to the end of your course, including all fees received. It is a requirement of the guarantees below that you comply as fully as possible with this clause.
7. We will award you a Certificate of Achievement as soon as you have earned your tuition fees from writing which you have sold. The award of a Certificate of Achievement confirms that The Writers Bureau College of Journalism is no longer liable for any refund of tuition fees under part (a) of the Guarantees below.

**8. YOUR GUARANTEES**

- (a) If you have not sold writing to the value of your Journalism Course fees by the time you have completed the last course assignment, we will refund the whole of your course fees on receipt of a written request, providing such request is received at our Manchester Office within six months of the completion of the last assignment. At the same time you must provide us with a selection of rejection letters to prove that you have been making every effort to sell your work.
- (b) You have the course on 15 days (in your possession) inspection trial when you enrol. If you post it to our Manchester Office within 15 days of receipt, any money you have paid will be refunded in full. This period will only be extended by request in advance.
- (c) We will pay you \$15 for every written assignment which is not properly corrected by your tutor. Failing agreement between us we both agree to accept independent arbitration as binding. This is in addition to any refund you may claim in clause (a) above.

# HOW TO START YOUR TRAINING

2. **Direct Bank Transfer – Quick and Safe**

You can now complete a transfer directly from your bank to ours which is safe and quick. You will need the following details:

3. **Sending your payment to England**

One of the best ways to send your fees is by sterling Bankers Draft drawn on a London Bank. YOU DO NOT NEED TO HAVE A BANK ACCOUNT TO OBTAIN A BANKERS DRAFT. You can buy one at any bank that conducts foreign exchange. Always tell the bank that your payment is for educational purposes. If the bank needs proof of this, show them your enrolment form and Writers Bureau prospectus.

**Make your draft payable to ‘The Writers Bureau College of Journalism’.**

When you have bought your draft, send it to us yourself together with your enrolment form. Do NOT let the bank send your payment to us. They will send it via a London bank who will impose heavy charges and we will have to pass these back to you. This way also causes long delays. So to avoid these extra charges and the delays buy a sterling draft and send it to us yourself. Bank drafts in currencies other than sterling also incur additional bank charges.

4. We can only accept personal cheques which are drawn on a UK bank (please make them payable to The Writers Bureau).
5. We can accept cash in sterling, US Dollars or any other currency that we can exchange in the UK. You should ALWAYS send cash by registered mail. If any cash sent by unregistered mail goes astray in the post we will not be responsible for this. It is your loss not ours.

**IMPORTANT** – the fees quoted on your enrolment form DO NOT INCLUDE BANK CHARGES. Any small amount your bank may charge you for a bank draft must be your responsibility. DO NOT deduct it from your fees.

## COURSE DESPATCH ARRANGEMENTS

- A. All course material, assignments and correspondence is sent by air. Where appropriate customs declaration labels are attached with the words “educational material no commercial value”. It is very rare that there are any problems with customs. However, if customs clearance should be required, or import duties imposed (again very rare) these must be your responsibility.
- B. If study material goes astray in the post we will provide replacements, completely free of charge, up to one complete course.
